TRANSFERRING LUGGAGE AND PASSENGERS BETWEEN DEPOTS IN CHICAGO

Passengers holding railroad tickets requiring change of stations in Chicago having three hours or more between trains, may deliver their hand luggage to the Parmelee desk at the incoming depots for delivery to the parcel checking rooms of the outgoing depots at the cost of only the usual checking fees.

REFERENCE NOTES

- A—Stops to discharge revenue passengers from Chicago, Joliet, Bloomington and Springfield.
- C—Stops on signal to receive revenue passengers for points where train is scheduled to stop.
- D—Stops to discharge revenue passengers from Chicago and receive revenue passengers for St. Louis.
- E—Stops to discharge passengers from Chicago and receive for St. Louis. Regular stop Sunday a.m.
- f—Stops on signal to receive and discharge revenue passengers.
- G—Stops on signal to receive revenue passengers for Springfield and beyond.
- H—Stops to discharge revenue passengers from Chicago.
- L—Also stops at Fifth Street, Lockport, to receive and discharge passengers.
- M. T.—Train does not operate through E. St. Louis but runs via Merchant's Terminal Bridge. Passengers can detrain at Washington Avenue and use bus or cab to E. St. Louis.
- N—Train operates one hour later than shown during period September 25, 1955 to April 29, 1956.
- X—Only through checked baggage and remains handled from Chicago to St. Louis.
